
Elections Officer

Vice-Chair for Membership Engagement: responsible for ensuring EYL members are kept informed of work the Exec does and running comms.

Policy & Regional Engagement Officer: coordinate policy across the regions and sit on YL Policy Committee

Regional Chairs (11): the Chair of each EYL Regional Exec: North East, North West, Yorkshire & Humber, East Midlands, West Midlands, East of England, London, South East, South Central, Western Counties, Devon & Cornwall

Campaigns Officer: responsible for running single-issue campaigns and working on Freshers in Scotland

Communications Officer: responsible for running SYL social media and emails to keep members informed

Policy Officer: responsible for submitting motions to YL, SLD and Lib Dem conferences.

Accessibility, Diversity and Enfranchisement Officer: responsible for improving diversity at all levels and making SYL events and the organisation accessible to all.

Campaigns Officer: plan single-issue campaigns based on WYL policy & values and coordinate Freshers

Policy Officer: responsible for organising WYL policy submissions to Welsh conference and sit on YL policy committee

Non-Portfolio Officer: assume vacant roles, and assist the Exec with project work or deputise at other meetings

Welsh Language Co-ordinator: promote the use of Welsh in WYL.

Honorary Officers



The Honorary President and six Honorary Vice-Presidents will:

- Support and advise the Executive (and Committees where necessary)
- foster positive relationships between YL and the rest of the party
- offer support to individual officers if needed

The Honorary President will serve a two-year term.

Honorary Vice-Presidents are elected three at a time, with elections staggered a year apart.

In the event of more than 3 vacancies, the 3 highestplaced candidates will serve two years, the 3 lowestplaced will serve one - **all 6 positions are up in 2023**.
