My past year as Under-18s representative:

I would view my past year as Under-18s rep in YL as very much a learning experience. The year I was elected as U-18s rep was my first year in YL and it has been great getting involved at all levels. I have been fighting for Under-18 representation at all levels, and have been developing programs I hope will be able to be implemented on a wider scale in the future. I believe a great showing of my progress has been the number of Under-18 candidates running this election for different positions, as well as the presence of Under-18s at London conference. I can proudly say that at London, everyone gave Under-18s much more respect and appreciation than at Sheffield, my first YL conference. Also, the numbers of U-18s attending the YL conference in London was 3 more people than in Sheffield, going from 8 to 11 people!

My plans if I get re-elected:

If I get re-elected I will implement programs which I have been trialling and testing this past year. These will include an official Under-18s forum, which can be an event held online twice a year before the YL conference. These meetings will be a way for us to try and jointly write U-18 focused policies to submit to conference, as well as get to know each other so that everyone doesn't feel lonely at YL conference as from personal experience as an Under-18 I know it can be hard. I also plan to expand a U-18 support scheme I have been trialling with candidates this election. This would involve connecting U-18s with experienced people in the organisation to get advice on running, as well as connecting them with U-18s who want experience designing posters. This scheme would give experience to all people involved, and would get more U-18s running for posts and therefore engaging with the organisation.
