

I will talk about myself now, but if ever you want to talk or have any ideas which you would potentially like to get into debate in the international committee, I am always open to talk and I'd love to hear what you would like to say. I have lived throughout Europe and the EU my entire life. I with the big 3 being in Romania, England and Poland. I have seen how the EU can be a force for good, as well as how diplomacy can solve any problem as long as countries are committed to it as a resolution. If I am elected, I will pass policy seeking to commit the Lib Dems and one day, when the Lib Dems are the governing party, the UK policy as a whole towards the route of diplomacy.

But, it will also add to law that UK universities have to accept IB, which will hopefully help international students through this codification. However, I promise to maintain our commitment with sister parties as well as organisations like LYMEC and IFLRY so as to work together for a better tomorrow. I will strengthen policy areas in such bodies as IFLRY that are lacking like Somaliland and education of international affairs in schools.

In Poland we were scarily close to Russian aggression and even were hit with missiles, which killed people. When many Ukrainian families fled, a lot of them fled to Poland, some left, but many stayed, some out of choice, but not all. If elected, I will ensure that policy is passed by the Lib Dems so as to not block refugees with bureaucracy, no matter where they are from. Also, to allow refugees and migrants to work, since many do want to and it will allow them to be less reliant on the government, but will also greaten their personal freedoms.

I will pass policy with the aim to fortify diplomatic channels with all other countries, but also ensure other countries do the same. The main body being the UN and making sure that it and other such bodies are listened to, respected and strengthened, since some countries are treating the demands of the security council as a suggestion, which is causing continued suffering in countries, also people are gridlocking the security council with veto and stopping necessary humanitarian actions.

I will also be calling for decisions to be made about unrecognised states like Somaliland which live in a limbo which is deeply hurting their populations since they lack the same access to diplomatic ties, aid from NGO'S and more. As well as calling for DISEC and other UN bodies trying to better maintain peace to be given more influence and for the UK to use such bodies to try and de-escalate conflicts before they have the chance to start

If I am elected I will work on policy which will better inform school children about the world and foreign affairs in a way which slowly deepens their understanding without subjecting them to bias from teachers or scaring children

If I am elected, I will keep calling for the international solution to the climate crisis which we are facing to be better employed, not to the exclusion of our national targets. I will work on

and pass policy which will work on developing the international diplomatic channels by better funding and prioritising UNEP and other such bodies, since through them countries can be better held to account, yet also better helped so as to better tackle this crisis across the world.
