5 priorities if I were your EYL Vice-Chair for Membership Engagement

Create an official line of communication for all regions

- Set up a WhatsApp community for the English Young Liberals, with specific groups for different roles within EYL.
- Committing to finding a way to allow u18s to join the WhatsApp communities.
- Set up regional WhatsApp communities.

Increased national and regional social media presence

- Ensure there is a comms officer in each region

- Training for regional chairs on how to manage their executives and how to engage with their community.
- Training for social media platforms & how to keep social media presence.

Organise more joint events and opportunities across regions
