- I was our Greenbank Park by-election candidate, achieving a 15.4% vote swing in just one month, in a ward left unworked for four years.
- Gained first-hand experience of the differences between local party execs and the YL Federal Exec, serving as Non-Portfolio Officer for YL Federal Exec 2024/2025.
- Law (LLB Hons) student and Membership Development / Communications Officer on the Liverpool Lib Dems Executive.
- Just under four years as a proud Liberal Democrat, active in both local and national campaigns.
- Supported Tom Morrison MP in Cheadle, helped secure a historic by-election win in Much Woolton & Hunts Cross, and backed Cllr Mike Ross's mayoral campaign in Hull & East Riding.
- President of Liverpool John Moores University Liberal Democrats Society, working closely with the University of Liverpool society to engage students in politics.
- Leader of "Your City, Your Voice" campaign, inspiring young people to value political engagement.
- Delivered workshops across mainstream & SEND schools, from primary to university level, teaching civic duty and the role of democracy.

- Promote YL campaigns and highlight members' successes, making sure our work is visible within and beyond the party.

- Ensure two-way communication by listening to members and feeding their voices into the heart of the Exec.

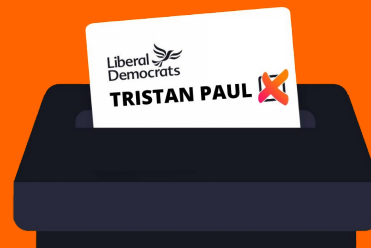
WHY AM I RUNNING?
