Economy, Welfare and Labour Relations

Saving the Hospitality Industry: cut punitive duties/rates, protect venues, and support post-pandemic revival.

Abolishing Sunday Trading Laws: scrap restrictions so shops can open when local demand exists.

In Support of Trade Unions: strengthen union rights, collective bargaining and workplace protections.

A Fair Deal for Young Workers: end age-based pay discrimination and boost enforcement of fair pay.

A Fair Deal for Slaughterhouse Workers: raise welfare, safety and oversight standards for meat-sector staff.

The Intergenerational Triple Lock: rebalance taxes/benefits to treat younger and older people fairly.

Taxing Gifts, Not Just Inheritance: create a broad gifts tax with generous allowances and fewer loopholes.

Holistic Approach to the UK's Economy: move beyond GDP to wellbeing, resilience and inequality metrics.

4 Day Work Week: pilot and promote shorter working weeks without loss of pay.

Home Affairs and Justice

Legalisation of Cannabis: regulate and tax cannabis with public-health safeguards.

For Fair and Effective Fines: tie fines to income so penalties fit ability to pay.

Protecting Asylum Seekers & Undocumented Immigrants: humane processes, safe routes and community support.

Liberal Approach to Surveillance Technology: strict oversight, privacy by design and accountability.

For a Fully Regulated Drug Market: shift to regulated supply and harm-reduction over prohibition.

Emergency: The Rise of the Far Right: proactive education, community safety, and defence of liberal democracy.

Social Justice

Black British Rights: close racial gaps in justice, health, housing and wealth.

Abolishing the Term BAME: use specific, respectful ethnicity descriptors instead of catch-all labels.

Public Sexual Harassment: criminalise PSH and make public spaces safer.

Children in Care & Care Leavers: guaranteed support, housing and education up to adulthood.

Funeral Support for Students & Young Adult Carers: targeted grants/leave after bereavement.

Confronting the Spiking Crisis: venue duties, testing, staff training and victim support.

Protecting GRT Communities: defend rights, halt discriminatory policies and improve site provision.

Sex Work: decriminalise sex work and improve safety and services.

Respecting Secularism & Humanism: uphold state neutrality on religion and belief.

Promoting Equality in the Playground: anti-bullying and inclusion standards in schools.

Disabled Marriage Equality: remove barriers so disabled people can marry without losing support.

Tackling Maternal Discrimination: enforce rights and penalise discriminatory employers.

Tackling Antisemitism & Reaffirming IHRA: robust action, education and adoption of IHRA.

Representation Is Not Optional: ensure women's representation in party and public life.

Hormone Blockers for Under-18s: evidence-based access to puberty blockers with clinical oversight.

Pride is a Protest: defend Pride's political roots and community safety.

Continuing the Journey to Equal Marriage: close remaining gaps in marriage equality.

Trans Children: affirming care, anti-bullying, and safeguarding of rights.

Opposition to Section 35 on GRR (Scotland): resist Westminster interference in devolved gender reform.

Somaliland Recognition Bill: explore recognition based on democratic performance.

Vocational Education & Apprenticeships: parity of esteem and quality standards.

Selective Schools: phase out academic selection and expand comprehensive excellence.

Protecting Arts & Humanities Education: safeguard funding and curriculum space.

Religious Education: A Way Forward: modern, plural and critical RE.

Reforming Citizenship Education: compulsory, high-quality civic education.

Poverty-Proofed Schooling: remove hidden costs that exclude pupils.

Abolish Fee-Paying Schools: integrate private schools into a fair system.

Active Travel for Youth Independence: fund safe walking/cycling networks.

The Climate Crisis: faster decarbonisation across all sectors.

Save Our Rivers: enforce against sewage/run-off and restore habitats.

Wild Camping: protect responsible public access to nature.

Avoiding Gridlock: Nuclear Energy: support safe new nuclear as part of the mix.

Direct Lithium Extraction (DLE): adopt cleaner lithium tech with safeguards.

Liberalising Britain's Railways: passenger-first reforms and transparent franchising.

National Housebuilding Targets: restore ambitious targets with local nuance.

Taking on the Housing Crisis: build more, protect renters and end homelessness.

Canals: A Place for All: invest in access, nature and heritage.

Repeal the Enclosures Act: modern land-access rights and commons.

High Speed Rail for Growth: build strategic high-speed links.

Stop the Anti-Pylon Pile-On: speed up grid upgrades for net zero.

Bus Travel in England: cheaper, more frequent and integrated buses.

Improve Transport Accessibility & Development: step-free access and joined-up planning.

Tackling Road Use: Novel Vehicle Taxation: fair, usage-based road pricing.

Abolishing Anti-Homelessness Architecture: ban hostile design in public spaces.
